 Should I/we no longer be able to care for the animal for any reason, I/we will return the animal to Friends of Animal Rescue. I understand that this is for the well-being and safety of the animal, and to ensure that it is placed in the right home.
 I understand that I assume full responsibility for the welfare of this pet from the date of adoption.
The animal will receive medical care by a qualified veterinarian, including annual distemper and parvo shots (DHLP), annual heartworm check, rabies shots whenever due, and any required medication for the life of the animal. The animal will be taken to a veterinarian whenever ill or injured. I will provide Friends of Animal Rescue with the name, address and telephone number of the animal's veterinarian.
